Over the past 18 months the JIRA team at Atlassian has been switching to a scrum development style. Veenu, one of the two QA engineers in a development team of 30, will share details on the challenges faced and the fun had while shipping a \$30mm product to over 20,000 customers globally during this transition to scrum. While this journey is far from complete we have made great progress in our ability to deliver quality fast. Come to this experience report to hear Veenu share approaches to mitigating risk, identifying quality issues early, and ensuring quality is built in from day one. Take away some tips that your quality assurance team can put into practice. **Learning Outcome** Learn from our success and failure, don't replicate our mistakes in your own project. Do: \* Educate devs to produce better code from start. \* Use DOTs (developers on test) \* Conduct early risk assessment \* Conduct QA demo's prior to Story completion \* Automated testing Don't: \* Over commit to testing all stories, focus on high risk \* Leave testing to the last minute
