Lifecycle models describe a comprehensive set of processes for software development and maintenance. As projects differ in business complexity and criticality, clarity and volatility of requirements,size, technical complexity, various lifecycle models have been developed to suit the needs of projects.Standard processes are applicable to projects and organizational functions.Sometimes the standard processes may not be a perfect fit with the situation at hand.Tailoring ensures the adoption of standard processes to meet specific needs while still being compliant with policies, regulatory obligations and relevant organizational standards.
